Built 24 new ramps and serviced 10 already existing ramps. One of the people we helped had not been out of her home in 5 years!

Collected, prepared, packaged and shipped 14,126 UMCOR kits worth \$ 289,666. (including flood relief supplies to Louisiana and Connellsville, PA)

We are holding another \$ 161,996 worth of kits (including 3,160 Cleaning Buckets) for future shipment or distribution

In 2016 Eastbrook Mission Barn took a number of steps to expand our ministry, including:

- Incorporated as a “stand-alone” charitable (501.c.3) corporation.
- Applied for and received the appointment of a General Board of Global Ministries missionary (Church and Community Worker), Katie Peterson, as our new Director.
- Expanded our mission to include [Poverty Alleviation](#) work in New Castle as well as [Addiction Recovery Support](#). (We will continue our work with **UMCOR**, Modular Ramps, Mission Education and Development, and Disaster Response support).
